Furthermore, it is **mandatory** for bidders to use a Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) for encryption/decryption of their bid data and for digital signing of bids. A DSC for the e-Procurement Class can be purchased from the Certification Authority Massign by applying online on the website <https://mausign.govmu.org>
