#### **EMPLOYMENT OF PSYCHOLOGISTS ON A SESSIONAL BASIS**

Applications are invited from qualified candidates not presently employed in the public sector who wish to be considered for employment as Psychologist on a sessional basis in the Ministry of Social Integration, Social Security and National Solidarity (Social Security and National Solidarity Division).

**A. Qualifications:** Candidates should possess a:

Bachelor Degree in Psychology and a Master's degree in Psychology (2 years), including documented supervised clinical training of a minimum of 400 hours during the course

**or**

Bachelor Degree in Psychology and a Master's degree in Psychology (1 year) including documented supervised clinical training of a minimum of 2 and a PhD Degree in Psychology, including documented supervised training of a minimum of 200 hours

**or**

*Licence/Bachelier en Psychologie* (3 years) and Master 1 (*Maîtrise*) *en Psychologie* and *Diplôme d'Etudes Supérieures Spécialisées* (DESS)/Master 2 level in Psychology, together with documented supervised clinical training of a minimum of 400 hours during the course

and registered in accordance with the Allied Health Professionals Council Act 2017.

**B. Age Limit:** The employment on contract of successful candidates shall not extend beyond the age of 70 years.

**C. Fees:** Psychologists on sessional basis will be remunerated as follows:

| SN | Period    | Fees per Session of 1 hour (Rs) |

| 1  | Weekdays  | 235                             |
| 2  | Saturdays | 360                             |
| 3  | Sundays   | 475                             |

**Note:** Only candidates possessing the appropriate qualifications will be considered for employment. Applications from candidates who have retired in the interest of the Public Service or on medical ground will not be considered.

The employment on a sessional basis will not give the selected candidates any claim for permanent appointment in the public service.

**D. Mode of Application**

Qualified candidates should submit their applications on the prescribed form, which may be obtained during office hours at the Human Resource Section of the Ministry of Social Integration, Social Security and National Solidarity (Social Security and National Solidarity Division), Level 10, Renganaden Seeneevassen Building, Cr.
